### Wins Álex Márquez Gresini Racing

There are circuits that never betray you. Jerez is one of them: a living, pulsating arena where the sun scorches the asphalt and every corner holds a memory, a duel, a shiver. Today, in this theatre of light and history, the spotlight belonged entirely to Álex Márquez, the author of a race that doesn't just aim for perfection — it surpasses it.

A dominance born from courage

From the moment the lights went out, it was clear that Álex had something different in his eyes. The start was a decisive brushstroke: clean line, stable bike, fierce determination. At the Pedrosa corner he overtook his brother Marc, in a move that felt written by destiny. And destiny, just one lap later, presented the bill to the elder Márquez: a lost front at the lightning-fast Turn 11, a slide that froze the crowd but left him unhurt.

From that moment on, Álex turned the race into a technical and emotional monologue. Surgical pace, sculpted braking points, a Gresini Desmosedici that seemed to read his thoughts. Lap after lap, he built an advantage that wasn't just time — it was authority.

The podium that completes the picture

Behind him, Marco Bezzecchi delivered an intelligent, solid race — the kind of performance that shows a rider who knows when to attack and when to protect. Fabio Di Giannantonio, in third place, confirmed his steady growth: precise, fast, mature. A podium that reflects a MotoGP that is alive, competitive, and unpredictable.

Marc and Bagnaia: the Sunday no one expected

The first twist came with Marc Márquez's retirement, crashing while chasing his brother in a duel that could have set the race on fire. The second arrived shortly after: Francesco Bagnaia forced to withdraw due to a technical issue. Two heavy absences that reshaped both the race and the championship.

Behind the lens: the truth of speed

As a photographer, as someone who has lived this paddock for a lifetime, I can say it without hesitation: today Álex Márquez showed the true fabric of a champion.

Every pass through the Nieto corner was a brushstroke of balance and controlled madness. Every braking move at Dry Sack was an act of total trust in his own abilities. Every lap carried a message: I'm here, and I'm ready to take what I deserve.

And as the sun set over the packed grandstands of Jerez, I felt I was witnessing not just a victory, but a turning point. The confirmation that Álex is no longer "Marc's brother," but a true protagonist of modern MotoGP. A rider who today lit a spark destined to burn for a long time.
